## POLICY: ST.JAMES BASKETBALL TEAMS COMPETING AT NATIONALS

NOTE: THE FOLLOWING POLICY HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE ST.

JAMES BOARD OF EDUCATION AND AFFECTS ONLY OUR SCHOOL'S

TEAMS REGARDLESS OF WHAT OTHER SCHOOLS MAY DO.

## **POLICY**

I. If it appears that a team may have the ability and record to compete at Nationals, the Athletic Director will apply within the January deadline.

## II. Qualification

A. If a team places 1<sup>st</sup> at the MN State Tournament, they would automatically qualify for the National Tournament in Indiana, and our team would participate in this tournament.

- B. Under the following circumstances/guidelines concerning St. James, a team could possibly accept an invitation to Nationals under the following situations if they finish  $2^{nd}$  or  $3^{rd}$  at State.
- 1. The team must be accepted from the Nationals nominating committee which looks at record, tournament finishes, league record, and State finish.
- 2. Under our guidelines, the team <u>must</u> have a solid overall win/loss record indicating that the team would be able to compete at the National level.
- \*\*NOTE: The cost of going to Nationals is significant (over \$5000). We would want our team to be able to compete at this level to justify the cost.
- 3. For a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place team (upon being accepted by the National's Committee) to be allowed to go to Indiana to participate the following situation will take place: Prior to the State Tournament the Board of Education, Athletic Director, the team coach(es), and the Principal will meet to discuss the various scenarios that would be acceptable for a St. James team to be allowed to participate at the National Tournament in Indiana.
- 4. No St. James basketball team will be allowed to go to Nationals under any other circumstances.
