<u>During the month of March families may take</u> advantage of early registration for the 2020-2021

school year. The educational materials fee during March will be \$125.00 per student in grades K-8 and \$75.00 for students in preschool.

After March 31st the educational materials fee per student for grades K-8 will be \$250.00 and for preschool it will be \$150.00. These fees are used to purchase textbooks and instructional materials for the classrooms. Financial assistance is available also for these fees if needed.
