Pastries with Parents on January 31 was a big success!

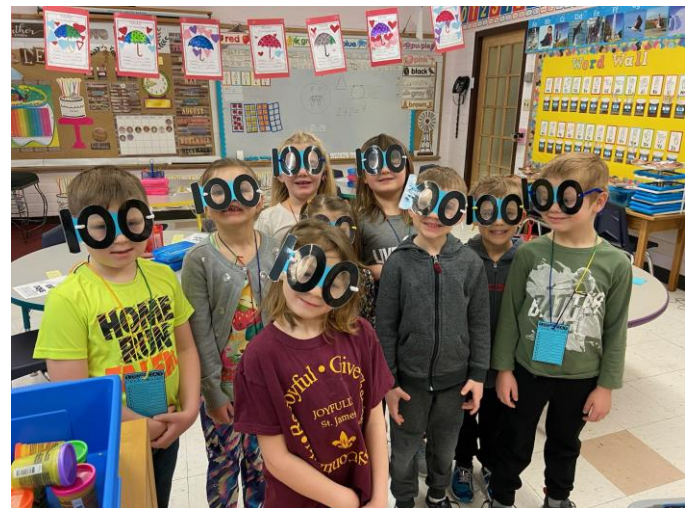
Everyone enjoyed the goodies and time to be together.
