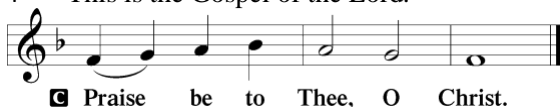
**Holy Gospel***Matthew 9:1–8*
