Remember to register for next school year by selecting yes for each child in the box at the bottom of your home page on Fast Direct. You may pay the registration fee through FDpay on that site, or by check directly to St. James Lutheran School. If paid before May 31st, the fees are \$125.00 per student in grades K-8 and \$75.00 for preschoolers. After that date the fee will be \$250.00 per student in K-8 and \$150.00 for preschool.
